A Father's Prayer







He had also been Chief of the Fulton County Sheriff's Posse.



Kevin Thornton's Letter

Member of Washington Shrine Club

My life is full of blessings, two arms, two legs, ten fingers, ten toes, two eyes, two ears, one nose and a mouth, and that's just the beginning. However, blessings come to us in many different ways, and I would like to share my story with you so that you too might find hope in your many blessings.

My name is Kevin Thornton and I was born with cerebral palsy (CP). When I was born, my parents were told that it was probable that I would never walk. However, my parents did not accept that and neither did the Shriners. The Shriners made having the surgeries and therapy I needed possible. Growing up I faced many challenges. At 4 years old, when most babies were learning to jump and run, I was having my first surgery to lengthen my heel cords. Much of my life seemed normal like everyone else. I had an older sister who was five years older than me, and she didn't cut me any slack growing up. While my parents worked, my grandmother took care of me, particularly following my surgeries.

Growing up with cerebral palsy also sometimes brought other trials that at the time seemed particularly rough on me, but now as I reflect on my childhood as an adult I realize that sometimes kids are just mean when someone is different from them. I often was picked on because I was different, but it just made me stronger because I decided to not give in or give up. I was a person who could do what other people do.

When I was 14, I faced my second surgery. Again, the Shriners helped me through. This surgery involved lengthening my hamstrings. Following the surgery, I was in the hospital for one month of physical therapy and had to basically learn to walk all over again. During that time, my school work was brought to the hospital and as I returned home I continued with homeschooling. Later I returned to school to finish out the school year with my class. I endured a lot of pain and it was not easy, but I had a lot of friends and family who loved me and helped me through.

Almost two years ago, I faced my third surgery for straightening my toes and I was sent home non-weight bearing for eight weeks followed by therapy. Through it all, with the Lord's help, I continue to get back on these two feet of mine every day and keep going. I have been a Shriner for seventeen years, and I am currently working to raise money and pray that I will be able to help others. Throughout the years, many people have been there for me. Nurses, doctors, physical therapists, the Shriners and most of all my family and friends, without them I would not be able to share these blessings with you. It is my hope and prayer that maybe my story will encourage someone, be the word you need to inspire you to push through the hard times, and realize that your life is full of blessings too, and when we are blessed it is so that we can bless others.


